1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 The Regatta Regulations of the International J/24 Class Association (IJCA) shall apply.
- 1.4 Support Persons- RRS 41 shall apply from the time a boat leaves her mooring for the first race of each day and until she returns to her mooring after racing. If RC displays Race Signal AP over H, RRS 41 restrictions are suspended until she leaves her mooring again. This changes the preamble to Part 4 rules.
- 1.5 In accordance with RRS G3, a boat chartered or loaned for this event may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of the class rules.
- 1.6 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.
- 1.7 RRS Appendix T: Arbitration shall apply to this event.
- 1.8 RRS 61.1(a) will be changed so that the red flag displayed by a protesting boat shall have a hoist of not less than 150mm and a fly of not less than 200mm.
- 1.9 Class rule C.2.1(b) will be replaced with class rule J.4.3 that allows limited crew substitution.
- 1.10 Class rule C.10.2 will be replaced by class rule J.2 that allows a spare spinnaker with restrictions.
- 1.11 RRS 60.4 (a)(1) is changed to read: "...but not rules 41, 42, 44, 46, and 49.2 sentences 1 and 2, or...."
- 1.12 RRS Appendix P shall apply with the following modifications:
 - 1.12.1 P1.1 is changed that observers may only be members of the protest committee.
 - 1.12.2 P1.2 is changed to read "An observer appointed under rule P1.1 who sees a boat breaking rule 42 or 49.2 may penalize her by, as soon as reasonably possible, making a sound signal, pointing a yellow flag at her and hailing her sail number or bow number, even if she is no longer racing. A boat so penalized shall not be penalized a second time under rule 42 or 49.2 for the same incident."
 - 1.12.3 P2.3 is deleted.
- 1.13 All changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

2 Advertising:

- 2.1 Competitor advertising shall comply with RRS 80 and World Sailing Regulation 20.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 Eligibility and Entry:

- 3.1 The European Championship is open to
 - J/24 Class boats as defined by the IJCA class rules, and
 - as prescribed in the IJCA Regatta Regulations, and
 - whose entries are accepted by the organizing authority.
- 3.2 Championship drivers/Helmsman must be either nationals or residents and members of the National J/24 Class Association of the country that they represent.
- 3.3 Eligible boats and their support Boats may enter by completing the required form on the Website of Manage2Sail [www.manage2sail.com] before the deadline of June 15th 2018. The entry fee shall be paid together with the registration. The fee is not refundable, even if the entry is cancelled later on or the boat does not show up. Entry fees will only be refunded if the entry is rejected by the FSC. The entry fee is non-refundable after 15 June 2018.
- 3.4 Late entries will be accepted but they will have to be confirmed by the FSC
- 3.5 If there are co-drivers /Helmsman, one of them shall be designated as the primary driver/Helmsman for this regatta.

4 Fees:

4.1 The required entry fee is:

- 5.2 Eleven races are scheduled over four consecutive days.
- 5.3 Three races are scheduled per day. One extra race per day may be sailed provided that the regatta does not become more than one race ahead of schedule. If the regatta is behind schedule, extra races to a maximum of four races may be sailed in a single day.
- 5.4 Last possible time for a warning signal is Fri. 27. July 2018, 16:25 hrs.

6 Registration and Inspection:

- 6.1 At registration each boat shall present:
- 6.2 A valid, IJCA issued Measurement Certificate, Including Part C: Inventory of Required and Optional Equipment. Boats that do not have a valid, IJCA issued Measurement Certificate must make arrangements to have their boat measured prior to the regatta. No first time or full measurement will be available during the scheduled regatta measurement time.
- 6.3 Proof of current marine third-party liability insurance coverage in the amount of 2.500.000,-€ per event or the equivalent.
- 6.4 Proof of J/24 Class Association membership in the country they represent for the owner and the driver(s)/helmsman.
- 6.5 All competitors will be weighed during registration. Competitors must have a passport or other photo identification at weigh-in.
- 6.6 Equipment Inspection will be carried out on all boats in accordance with the class rules.
- 6.7 Boats will be subject to inspection at any time and for any class rules during the regatta.

7 Sailing Instructions:

7.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available from Saturday July 21st at registration.

8 Venue:

8.1 Attachment A shows the location of the regatta harbor and the racing areas.

9 The Courses:

- 9.1 The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward with 4 or 5 legs.
- 9.2 The target time for each race is approximately 60-75 minutes.
- 9.3 An offset mark at the weather mark will be used. Exceptions will be described in the Sailing Instructions
- 9.4 A gate at the leeward mark will be used. Exceptions will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

10 Penalty System:

- 10.1 In accordance with RRS 64.1, class specified penalties will apply for breaking some IJCA rules. See J/24 Class Rule Penalties on the Class website. These penalties will be posted on the official Notice Board.
- 10.2 Decisions of the international jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

11 Scoring:

- 11.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.
- 11.2 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.3 When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, excluding her worst score.

12 Support Boats:

12.1 Support boats shall check in during scheduled registration, declaring to which boat or boats they are attached. They may be required to display an identification supplied by the organizing authority.

13 Berthing:

13.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the harbour Glücksburg and the club area of the FSC/DHH.

14 Haul-out Restrictions:

14.1 Boats shall be afloat by 18:00 on Monday, 23 July, 2018 and shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with, and according to the terms of prior written permission of the jury. This includes rudders.

15 Diving Equipment, Plastic Pools and Other Prohibited Actions:

- 15.1 Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used between the time the boat is afloat and the end of the regatta. The hull may be cleaned at any time by swimming or keelhauling using ropes, cloth or other equipment designed for that use.
- 15.2 Careening by any means for the purpose of cleaning or inspecting the hull is prohibited during the regatta.

16 Radio Communication:

- 16.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This shall apply from the time she leaves her mooring for the first race of the day until racing for the day is complete.
- 16.2 The race committee may choose to make VHF radio communications to the fleet on a channel to be announced. It is strongly encouraged that each boat have a VHF radio on board capable of receiving these communications.

17 Prizes:

17.1 The European Championship title will be awarded to the top finishing boat from among entries from European countries.

- 17.2 Trophies will be awarded depending on the number of entries. There will be one trophy every five boats entered up to a maximum of twenty Trophies.
- 17.3 Best all female crew.
- 17.4 Best Junior crew (all crew members U25).

18 Disclaimer of Liability:

- 18.1 The responsibility for the decision of the person in charge to participate in a race or to continue with it is solely with him, to that extent he also takes the responsibility for his crew. The helmsman is responsible for the qualification and the correct nautical conduct of his crew as well as for the suitability and the transport-safe condition of the registered boat. In cases of Force Majeure or on grounds of administrative orders or for safety reasons the organizer is entitled to make changes in the realization of the event or to cancel the event. In these cases, there does not exist any liability for compensation of the organizer to the participant. In case of a violation of obligations that do not constitute primary respectively material contractual duties (cardinal obligations), the liability of the organizer, no matter because of which cause in law, for material and property damages of all kinds and their consequences that arise to the participant during or in connection with the participation in the event resulting from a conduct of the organizer, his representatives, servants or agents, is restricted to damages that were caused will fully or grossly negligent. When a violation of cardinal obligations occurs, in cases of simple negligence the liability of the organizer is limited to foreseeable, typically occurring damages. To the extent that the liability for damages of the organizer is excluded or restricted, the participant also relieves the staff – employees and representatives, agents, servants, sponsors and individuals who provide or drive salvage, safety or rescue vessels or assist with their use from the individual liability for damages, as well as also all other individuals who were instructed to act in connection with the realization of the event. The effective Racing Rules of WS, the class rules as well as the regulations of the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions are to be complied with and are expressly recognized.
- 18.2 All competitors will be required to sign a Competitor Liability Waiver form to be provided in the registration package.
- 18.3 The law of the Federal Republic of Germany applies.

19 Insurance:

19.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party insurance with a minimum coverage of 2.500.000,- € per event or the equivalent.

20 Media Rights:

20.1 Competitors give absolute right and permission to the IJCA, the German J/24 Class Association, the FSC and the event sponsors to use, publish, broadcast or otherwise distribute for promotional, advertising or any other purpose, any images and sound recorded during the event of persons and boats free of any charge.


