NOTICE OF RACE

KDY March Match Race Cup Gr. 4 - 2022

Royal Danish Yacht Club

Skovshoved Harbour

1 ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Organising Authority (OA) will be the KDY - Royal Danish Yacht Club.

2 VENUE

The venue will be at Skovshoved Harbour, Denmark.

3 EVENT GRADING

The event is a World Sailing Grade 4.

This grading is subject to review by World Sailing. The event may be re-graded when there is a clear reason to do so.



4 PROVISIONAL PROGRAMME

4.1 Schedule

- (a) Race office open from 08.00, Saturday, 26-03-2022
- (b) Registration from 08.00 to 09.00 Saturday, 26-03-2022.
- (c) Crew weighing from 08.00 to 09.00 Saturday, 26-03-2022
- (d) Skippers' meeting Saturday, 26-03-2022 at 09.00 and Sunday, 27-03-2022 at 09.00.
- (e) No practice possible
- (f) First meeting with umpires at 09.00 Saturday
- (g) Racing days are on 26th and 27th March, 2022
- (h) Time of the first race Saturday will be at 09.45. First race Sunday at 09.45.
- (i) The latest time for an attention signal on the last day of racing will be approximately 16.00
- (j) Event BBQ Party starts at 19:00 at the KDY Club house - to be confirmed
- (k) Prize giving on 26th of September after last race

4.2 Unless excused by the OA, attendance at the following is mandatory:

- (a) Skippers meeting Saturday and Sunday
- (b) Prize giving for the final skippers and crews.

5 SKIPPERS ELIGIBILITY

- 5.1 [10 crews will be invited](#). Only skippers invited by the OA will be eligible to enter this event.
- 5.2 The registered skipper shall helm the boat at all times while racing, except in an emergency.
- 5.3 To remain eligible a skipper shall confirm acceptance of the invitation in writing, to be received by the date specified on the letter of invitation.
- 5.4 N/A
- 5.5 All competitors shall meet the eligibility requirements of World Sailing regulation 19.2.
- 5.6 All competitors shall obtain a World Sailing Sailor ID by registering online at www.sailing.org/isafsailor. Skippers shall inform the OA of their World Sailing Sailor ID at registration.

6 ENTRIES

6.1 Entering

- (a) The skipper/team shall be entered on completion of registration, crew weighing and the payment of all fees and deposits. All payments shall be made by credit card.

6.2 Entry Fee

A non-refundable entry fee of **180 Euros** shall be paid no later than 18-03-2022.

The entry fee includes:

- (a) Free small breakfast Saturday and Sunday morning in the club house



6.3 Withdrawal

When a skipper accepts an invitation and later withdraws within 1 months of the event or leaves the event before the end without written approval from the OA, a zero score may be applied to their Ranking points for that event by World Sailing. (World Sailing Regulation 27.2)

6.4 Damage deposit

- (a) A **1.000 Euros** deposit must be paid by credit card at registration Saturday morning. It will be returned after the race Sunday on the same credit card if the skipper/crew has not been involved in damage of the boats. If a skipper/crew makes a damage the OA can demand a new damage deposit before the skipper/crew can continue racing.
- (b) Members of the KDY Sailing Centre Skovshoved are exempt from paying damage deposit.

6.4 Insurance

The boats are insured by Royal Danish Yacht Club for amounts larger than the damage deposit.

7 RULES

- 7.1 (a) The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the RRS, including Appendix C.
- (b) The rules for the handling of boats will apply, and will also apply to any practice sailing and sponsor races. Class rules will not apply.
- (c) Any prescriptions of the national authority that will apply will be posted on the official notice board.
- (d) PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICES RRS 40.1 applies at all time when afloat.

7.2 Major Alterations to the RRS

- (a) Add to RRS 41: (e) help to recover from the water and return on board a crew member, provided the return on board is at the approximate location of the recovery.
- (b) RRS C8.6 and C6.3 will be changed in the sailing instructions or Notice of Race.

8 BOATS AND SAILS

- 8.1 The event will be sailed in DS37 type boats and [J/80](#).
- 8.2 [Four](#) DS37 boats will be provided and two [J/80](#) boats will be provided
- 8.3 The following sails will be provided for each boat: Mainsail, Jib/Genoa and Spinnaker.
- 8.4 Boats will be allocated by draw, either daily or for each round as decided by the race committee. Boats will be paired by boat class.



9 CREW (INCLUDING SKIPPER)

9.1 The number of crew (including the skipper) shall be 4. All registered crew shall sail all races. (All woman crews can be 5 including the skipper)

9.2 Crew Weighing

- (a) The total weight of the crew, including the skipper, dressed in at least shorts and shirts, shall not exceed 350.0 kg, determined at the time of registration or such time as required by the RC.

10 EVENT FORMAT

10.1 Skippers will be seeded into a round robin or divided in one group based on draw.

10.2 The event will consist of the following stages: A full round robin plus semi-finals and finals.

10.3 The RC may change the format, terminate any stage or the event when, in its opinion, it is impractical to attempt to hold the remainder of matches under the existing conditions or in the remaining time scheduled. Early stages may be terminated in favour of later stages.

11 COURSE

11.1 The course will be windward/leeward with starboard roundings, finishing downwind.

11.1 The course will be windward/leeward with optional offset legs in the event of cross course current, resulting in either port or starboard roundings and finishing downwind.

11.2 The intended course area will be outside Skovshoved Harbour.

12 ADVERTISING is not allowed

13 PRIZES

13.1 There will be a small prize to the three best crews of the Skovshoved Open.

15 COACH BOATS are not allowed unless written approval from OA.

18 INVITATIONS
