Procedural Matters: AUS 199012 showed a video.	
Facts found: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The wind was very light with small waves.2. CYP 212431 and AUS 199012 were both on starboard tack sailing towards the last downwind mark (3P).3. CYP 212431 was the inside boat overlapped and to leeward of AUS 199012 when entering the zone.4. At the mark AUS 199012 was still overlapped with its bow ½ a boat length ahead of CYP 212431.5. AUS 199012 gybed.6. After the gybe of AUS 199012, the distance between the mark and AUS 199012 was about a boat length.7. CYP 212431 gybed just after AUS 199012.8. Had CYP 212431 not gybed, she would have hit AUS 199012 amidships.9. There was 30 cm between CYP 212431 and the mark after her gybe.10. There was ½ a boat width between CYP 212431 and AUS 199012 after the gybe of CYP 212431.11. There was no contact between CYP 212431 and AUS 199012 and no contact between CYP 212431 and the mark.12. No one took penalty turns.	
Conclusion: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. AUS 199012 outside overlapped gave CYP 212431 mark room as required by RRS 18.2b.2. CYP 212431, as an inside overlapped right of way boat which must gybe at the mark, sailed no further than her proper course until she gybes, as required by RRS 18.4.3. AUS 199012 on port failed to keep clear of CYP 212431 on starboard, and broke RRS 10.
