

HELSINKI REGATTA FOR KEELBOATS 17th - 18th June 2023 Notice of Race

The Helsinki Regatta for keelboats 2023 is an open international regatta, organized by Helsinki Sail Racing Management (HSRM). Members of HSRM are seven leading Helsinki-based sailing clubs.

1 Rules

- 1.1. The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text shall take precedence.
- 1.3. RRS Appendix S (Standard Sailing Instructions)

2. Advertising

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen as supplied by the Organizing Authority.

3. Eligibility and registration

- 3.1. The regatta is open to boats of the following classes: 8mR, 6mR, Dragon, Star, 5.5m, 5m, X-99, Albin Express, Finn Express, H-boat, Folkboat, Hai.
- 3.2. A class is opened only if, unless otherwise agreed in writing, not less than four (4) boats have registered by 11:59 pm on 12th June.
- 3.3. Eligible boats shall register by completing the registration form available on **www.manage2sail.com/fi-FI** and paying the entry fee not later than 11:59 pm on 16th June.
- 3.4. Several classes may be combined into one start.

10. Regatta venues

Boats may sail directly to the racing area from their home ports.

11. Course areas, courses and classes

Area K (North of Rysäkari): 5.5m, 5m, H-boat, Folkboat, Hai, Albin Express, Finn Express

Area E (Ytterskär): 8mR, 6mR, Dragon, Star.

Coursers will be windward/leeward or trapezoidal.

13.Scoring

The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A will apply. No race scores will be excluded from a boat's series unless four (4) or more races are completed.

19.Prizes

Prizes are awarded as recommended by the Finnish Sailing and Boating Federation.

20. Liability disclaimer and Insurance

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (ISAF fundamental rules 3- Decision to race). The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with adequate cover per event (min. 200.000€) and valid for racing.

22.Media release

Competitors and crew members on the competing yachts and support boats grant, at no cost to HSRM and sponsors and affiliated companies the absolute right and permission to use their name, voice.
